


Market Intelligence Update Australian Avocado Exports Weekly to 16 July 2023 This report was developed for Avocados Australia Ltd from data of the Department of Agriculture Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) Plant Export Operation for use by the Australian Avocado industry only. This report gives the Australian Avocado industry an insight on previous and current year export performance.

Australian Avocado exports for the start of FY24 were 958 tonnes which was 37 per cent above the same period in 2022/23, although this overlaps the last week of FY23. Exports in the latest week were 314 tonnes. Hong Kong, Singapore, and Malaysia accounted for 96 per cent of all exports in FY23.. The first consignments to India have now been recorded with 10.5 tonnes to date. The ABS data for latest 11 months to May 2023 records 9,591 tonnes exported worth A\$52.3m with a unit value of A\$5.45 per kg (Table 3). If this was extrapolated to the 2023/24 YTD result the value would be \$5.2m for the first 3 week period subject to final ABS data.
