

Monthly Export / Import Update

October 2023

By October of the 2023/24 year, exports of avocados recorded 7,576 tonnes worth A\$30.85m and was 105 per cent above the same period last year (Table 1). The overall value increased by 65 per cent. Unit values were 19.6 per cent lower at AU\$4.07 per kg (FOB). The MAT (Moving Annual Total) was 14,544 tonnes, up 10.6 per cent since the previous month's MAT showing a very strong positive momentum.

Hong Kong was the lead market with 3,090 tonnes, up 86 per cent followed by Singapore (+46%) and Malaysia (+155%). These markets accounted for 84 per cent of the exports to date.


There were 677 tonnes exported to Japan (+394%) from Western Australia, and the first 225 tonnes to Thailand since the new protocol. (Table 3).

Western Australia was the largest export state for the period and 790 per cent higher to 2,380 tonnes. Queensland was 5 per cent lower to 2,182 tonnes for the 4 months to October (Table 2).

On a month to month basis the October exports were 178 per cent higher at 2,176 tonnes compared to 782 tonnes a year ago and FOB prices were 36 per cent lower at A\$3.89 per kg (Figure 1).



Sea freight accounted for 47 per cent of avocado shipments in July- Oct lifting 212 per cent compared to Oct last year.

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MARKET INSIGHTS

Hong Kong (Oct 23)

Hong Kong imported 11,131 tonnes of avocados from July to October 2023, which was 61.5 per cent more than the previous year. More than 60 per cent is re-exported to China. Australia supplied 3,107 tonnes or 80 per cent more. Peru is the largest supplier and was up 138 per cent to 6007 tonnes where most of this is reexported to China. Mexico was 64 per cent lower to 354 tonnes.

Singapore (Oct 23)

Singapore imported 2,217 tonnes of avocados from July to October 2023, 20 per cent more than last year. Australia supplied 1,892 tonnes or 30 per cent more than a year ago accounting for 85 per cent market share. Kenya was unchanged at 102 tonnes while China entered the market with 37 tonnes.

Malaysia (Sept 23)

Malaysia has imported 1,395 tonnes of avocados from July to September 2023, which was 46 per cent more than last year. Australia supplied 1.021 tonnes or 69 per cent more than last year and holds 73 per cent market share. Kenya increased 59 per cent to 181 tonnes and 13 per cent market share. Australian CIF prices were recorded A\$4.78 average for the year and dropped to \$4.03 in August possibly under pressure from low offers from Kenya recording \$2.31 per kg.

Japan (Sept 23)

Japan imported 20,640 tonnes of avocados from July to October 23 which is 25.6 per cent higher than last year. Australia supplied 312 tonnes. Mexico, the lead supplier over a year, was 37 per cent higher to 10,666 tonnes though recovering from a lower volume year. Peru increased 15 per cent to 9,516 tonnes to finish their season. Australia's recorded average CIF price was A\$4.47 compared to average A\$3.96 from all sources.

Thailand (Sept23)

Thailand imported 470 tonnes of avocados from July to September 23 and is 11 per cent lower than last year. **The first 34 tonnes from Western Australia were recorded**. New Zealand supplied 286 tonnes and Peru has supplied 150 tonnes leading to a changeover period to NZ supply.

India (Aug 23) no later data

India imported 882 tonnes of avocados from July to August 23 and is 52 per cent above last year. Tanzania supplied 852 tonnes and now accounts for 97 per cent share.

Netherlands (ex Peru) is 77 per cent lower and there are no other suppliers expect for 3 tonnes from New Zealand. Australia's first consignments were recorded in June and July, with the July consignments recorded here.

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The imports for the 2023/24 import have commenced from New Zealand. Imports of avocados were **772** tonnes worth A\$3.40m or 81 per cent less than last year (Table 11). Unit values decreased 0.2 per cent to A\$4.41 and has meant the overall value decreased by 81 per cent for the period. The MAT (Moving Annual Total) was 9,555 tonnes decreasing 16.6 per cent in the month.


