

Monthly Export / Import Update January 2024

By January of the 2023/24 year, exports of avocados recorded **12,961** tonnes worth A\$55.28m and was **139 per cent** above the same period last year (Table 1). The overall value increased by 88 per cent. Unit values were 22 per cent lower at AU\$4.26 per kg (FOB). The MAT (Moving Annual Total) was 18,212 tonnes, up 10 per cent since the previous month's MAT maintaining a very strong positive momentum.

Hong Kong remains the lead market with 4,997 tonnes, up 130 per cent followed by Singapore (+59%) and Malaysia (+167%). These markets accounted for 82 per cent of the exports to date and reducing with diversification.

There were 924 tonnes exported to Japan (+234%) from Western Australia, and 561 tonnes to Thailand since the new protocol. (Table 3). Trade to Middle East recorded 985 tonnes compared to just 18 tonnes last year.

Western Australia was the largest export state for the period and 500 per cent higher to 6,335 tonnes. Queensland was 9 per cent lower to 2,434 tonnes for the 7 months to January (Table 2).



On a month to month basis the January exports were 700 per cent higher at 1,868 tonnes compared to 225 tonnes a year ago and FOB prices were 27 per cent lower at A\$4.97 per kg (Figure 1).

MARKET INSIGHTS

Hong Kong (Jan 24)

Hong Kong imported 15,336 tonnes of avocados from July to January 2024, which was 46.6 per cent more than the previous year. More than 60 per cent is re-exported to China. Australia supplied 5,001 tonnes or 117 per cent more. Peru is the largest supplier and was up 131 per cent to 6,254 tonnes where most of this is reexported to China. Mexico was 78 per cent lower to 467 tonnes.

Singapore (Jan 24)

Singapore imported 3,640 tonnes of avocados from July to January 2024, 22.4 per cent more than last year. Australia supplied 3,122 tonnes or 49 per cent more than a year ago accounting for 86 per cent market share. New Zealand was 59 per cent lower at 133 tonnes. China has entered the market with 68 tonnes. Kenya supplied 104 tonnes which is tracking 38 per cent lower for the period. Mexico is 56 per cent lower to 28 tonnes.

Malaysia (Nov 23) (no update)

Malaysia has imported 2,469 tonnes of avocados from July to November 2023, which was 50 per cent more than last year. Australia supplied 2,009 tonnes or 100 per cent more than last year and holds 81 per cent market share. Kenya increased 25 per cent to 181 tonnes and 7 per cent market share. Australian CIF prices were recorded A\$4,31 average for the year and dropped to \$3.85 in November possibly under pressure from low offers from Kenya recording \$2.31 per kg.

Japan (Jan 24)

Japan imported 33,600 tonnes of avocados from July to January 24 which is 13.5 per cent higher than last year. Australia has supplied 844 tonnes. Mexico, the lead supplier over a year, was 11 per cent higher to 22,897 tonnes and recovering from a lower volume year in 2022. Peru increased 15 per cent to 9,516 tonnes to finish their season. Australia's recorded average CIF price was A\$4.46 compared to average A\$3.98 from all sources.

Thailand (Jan 24)

Thailand imported 1,203 tonnes of avocados from July to January 24 and is 7.1 per cent higher than last year. Australia has now supplied more than Peru with 494 tonnes from Western Australia recorded. New Zealand supplied 560 tonnes, down 23 per cent, and Peru supplied 150 tonnes before the changeover period to NZ supply. Australia appears to now be contributing to market growth.

India (Dec 23)

India imported 2,197 tonnes of avocados from July to December 23 and is 86 per cent above the same period last year. Tanzania supplied 2,018 tonnes and now accounts for 92 per cent share. Netherlands (ex-Peru) is 87 per cent lower. New Zealand has supplied 99 tonnes. Australia's first consignments were recorded in June and July, with the July consignments recorded here though more will flow from January where 480 tonnes have been recorded by other sources until end of February. This is more than India imported from all sources in Jan/Feb 2022.

Monthly Export / Import Update January 2024

IMPORTS

The imports for the 2023/24 import are tracking 77 per cent lower than last year. Imports of avocados were **2,877** tonnes worth A\$13.46m (Table 11). Unit values increased 3.4 per cent to A\$4.68 and has meant the overall value decreased by 76 per cent for the period. The MAT (Moving Annual Total) was 3,267 tonnes decreasing 52 per cent in the month.
