The Horticulture Australia (HAL) Independent Review is now at the stage where all of the submissions by stakeholders have been made and these can be viewed online by <u>clicking here</u>. In all 47 submissions were made by a range of stakeholders.

As you know the Review involves an examination of HAL's service delivery and operational model, as well as the efficiency of levy arrangements. Apparently the consultants are in the process of considering this input and will provide their final report to the Minister the Honourable Barnaby Joyce and the HAL Board on 3 May 2014. It is expected that in late May Avocados Australia, along with other HAL members, will then be considering the review's findings and recommendations.

A new permit has been issued for Methomyl (Lannate L) for the treatment of Ectopis looper in avocado (NSW and QLD only). Permit number 14597, held by Avocados Australia, is current for five years. Please <u>click here</u> to view the permit directly.

Permit 14597 will be in force from the 1 April 2014 until 31 March 2019. Please note that the current permit (PER11284) expires on 31 March 2014.
