The Tristate Qualicado Workshop will take place on Thursday the 14th of November at Bonyaricall Vineyards, 55 O'Connor Lane Robinvale. All avocado growers and packers in the

area are invited to attend. The program includes information on how to achieve maximum shelf life, understanding tree growth cycles and canopy management and of course an opportunity to learn more about the Qualicado program.
