North Queensland Qualicado attendees - Du-Wett caution

At the NQ avocado field day on Thursday 14 July Simon Newett included in his presentation some information on the use of Du-Wett spreader in low volume phosphorous acid foliar sprays.

Simon would like to caution growers about the use of Du-Wett and phosphorous acid especially when there are residues of copper on the avocado leaves.

In some situations this has resulted in burn to leaves and fruit, the exact causes are unclear.
