ACCC Agriculture Unit to visit Mildura

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission Agriculture Unit is visiting Mildura and is keen to meet with local growers on the afternoon of August 29th 2016.

The ACCC Commissioners will provide information and take questions on its role in relation to collective bargaining and the upcoming business-to-business unfair contract terms laws.
