


Location Map & Directions:

Venue: B & M Trousdell, 213 Mt Binga Rd, Mt Binga (via Blackbutt) QLD

From Brisbane:

Take National Route 17 to Hart St in Blackbutt - 160 km / 1 h 53 min
Take Blackbutt Crows Nest Rd and Nukku Rd to Mount Binga Rd - 19.6 km / 38 min
Turn left onto Hart St - 1.1 km
Continue onto Blackbutt Crows Nest Rd - 6.1 km
Continue onto Nukku Crows Nest Rd - 1.5 km
Turn right onto Nukku Rd - 8.0 km
Nukku Rd turns slightly left and becomes Mount Binga Rd,
Destination will be on the right - 2.9 km
